TIME TO BE A DISTRICT OFFICER

All candidates must submit an application that:

- Lists JOOI or Optimist activities in which they participated
- Indicates why candidate should be elected
- Is signed by both the candidate and a parent or guardian

All elected officers are required to:

- Provide a picture and goals statement to for the GATEway Optimist Web site
- Attend Board Meetings in various locations up to four times a year
- Attend the GATEway JOOI District Convention
- Vote as needed on matters before the Board
- Assist in the planning and promotion of the annual JOOI District and International JOOI Conventions.

REWARDS FOR DISTRICT SERVICE

All elected officers receive:

- Certificates indicating office held
- Nationally approved training in areas such as parliamentary procedure, leadership, team building, and public speaking – with completion certificates
- Experience in fund raising
- Participation in fun activities and service projects

Certificates and experience on a state level is good for inclusion with college applications.

DISTRICT OFFICER RESPONSIBILITIES

The officers of the GATEway JOOI District are the Governor, Governor-Elect, the Lieutenant Governors, and the District Secretary / Treasurer.

The **Governor's** duty is to further the purposes of JOOI and the GATEway JOOI District, and to promote the interest and coordinate the work of member clubs within the JOOI District. He/she shall provide input to generally oversee and encourage JOOI Club activities within the District. The Governor presides at all meetings of the Executive Board, the Board of Directors, and performs such other duties as ordinarily incumbent upon a Governor.

The **Governor-Elect** shall perform such duties as are ordinarily incumbent upon a Governor-Elect and perform such other duties as may be assigned by the Governor and Board of Directors.

Each **Lieutenant Governor** coordinates the activities of an assigned group of Clubs. He/she shall communicate with the Governor and attend JOOI District Board Meetings.

The Secretary / Treasurer records minutes of the Executive Board meetings, the Board of Directors meetings, processes all correspondence, and generally performs such duties as are incumbent upon a secretary. The GATEway Optimist District Secretary / Treasurer shall be responsible for maintaining all funds.
